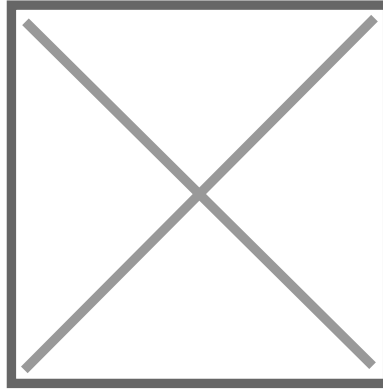




CSI – Who Dunnit?
